There are no TVs or phones in the room. Phone service is available through their business office, and a satellite television is conveniently located in the Frangipani Bar for viewing.

Laundry Service: Can be done by outside service for a fee. Same day service.

Beach Towels: There are towels in the room and at poolside. You need to bring your own towel for the boat. Note they do not like you taking the pool towels to the boat, but I do it. If you have room in your bag you may want to bring a boat towel.

Internet Access: Free Wi-Fi throughout resort

Food: 3 meals per day.

Money: To convert a US dollar to lempira is \$1 = L24.08 per Dollar rate on Wednesday June 23, 2021. US Dollars accepted at the resort. You can use credit cards or cash to check out.

Tipping: Divemasters, captain, dive crew, cleaning lady, boat taxi, airport taxi, luggage handlers, waiters, and any guides you use on the trip. All tips will be collected at the end of the week. Note: Tipping is a personal preference, not a requirement. You can tip more or less as you see fit. Dive tips estimated \$5 to \$10 per tank.

Electricity: Same as U.S.

Climate: Avg mid to upper 80's; Evening temps 79-80 degrees

Dress: T-shirts and shorts. Dress is very relaxed and casual. Nights may have a cool breeze. Most of the time you will be in t-shirts and shorts. There are no hairdryers in the rooms.

Departure Tax: Paid in airline tickets.

Proof of Citizenship: **Must** have valid Passport with at least six months left before expiration date.

Medicine: Since we are on a remote section of the island, I recommend bringing your own first aid kit: aspirins, decongestants. Band-aids, motion sickness pills, **Peptobismol**, **Imodium AD**, suntan lotion, **Bug Repellant**, contact lens fluid, Aurocaine eardrops, or any other medication that you may need.

Shots: Always best to check the www.cdc.gov website to see if any shots are recommended.

Water Temp: 83-84 degrees **Water Visibility:** 75-150 feet

Diving: Approximately 35 distinct dive sites located within 10-20 minutes of the resort, providing a variety of caves, ledges, tunnels, holes, walls, sand chutes, and eel gardens.

Dive Package 6 Days diving - 3 Boat dives per day with tanks and weights supplied. Shore diving from 3pm – 7:00pm. Also, 2 boat single tank night dives per week. No diving within 24 hours of your flight home.

Baggage Allowance – Check with your airline.

Anthony Key Green Luggage Tags: Make sure you put one on each checked bag when you get to Roatan. Anthony's Key will take your luggage at baggage claim and bring it to your room.

Roatan Airport Transfers: The staff will meet you just outside baggage claim. Look for their sign. They will take your luggage for you. (Important to put green tags on with your name as soon as comes out of baggage conveyor belt. It is about a 20-minute ride to the airport.

Students: We will meet at 2pm at the dive shop check you in. Get your weights and any equipment you will need. We will brief the dives and start dive one at 3pm. Make sure you bring your logbook and safety sausage that was in your student kit.

Dan Insurance: Strong recommendation – To become a DAN member and sign up for the insurance visit their website at dan.org.

Trip Insurance: Strongly recommended. You can purchase trip insurance on our website. Go to the Roatan trip page, click on pricing, then click on the icon that says Travel Guard.

Rental Equipment Reservations – If you need to rent equipment from MASS Diving, please reserve ahead of time. Note our equipment is better quality, newer, and less expensive. Regulator with computer is \$78 BCD weight integrated is \$48.00.

Regulators/BCD – Let me know what regulator and BC you have so I can have part kits in my spare parts kit.

Covid-19 – Procedures: (see links in the email I sent)

If you are fully vaccinated for COVID-19 and traveling at least 14 days after your final shot, you DO NOT need to get tested for COVID-19. Bring your card with you.

If you are not vaccinated, you will need a negative COVID-19 test, taken not more than 72 hours prior to your entry to Honduras. **Accepted Tests for COVID-19:**

1. Rapid Antigen Test for detection of COVID-19
2. Polymerase Chain Reaction Test (rt-PCR) in real-time.

All travelers vaccinated or not are required to comply with airport biosecurity protocols:

1. Wear face coverings correctly.
2. Maintain social distancing.
3. Use hand sanitizing gel as instructed.

At this time everyone will need a negative Covid test to return to the USA. The resort will make arrangements at our expense.
